Executes the Slavonic resolution ruled in EA-OMEGA-BUILD-01: first the documented negative search, corner by corner with queries as run — no repository, no code corpus, no scanned Berendts 1906 among the author's archive.org holdings — concluding that no openly licensed machine-readable text of the recension exists in the searched corners; then the curated contested-status set: the eight Jesus-and-John pericopes as defined by The Word That Became Text (#1176, Appendix II), indexed with titles, paraphrases, per-passage provenance (Leeming and Leeming collation with Berendts and Meshcherskii consulted), the transmission chain from Popov 1866 through Pines 1971, and status CONTESTED throughout — carried as reception data, never as canonical Josephus. Text layer pending a public-domain witness. Twelfth seat, closing the initial EA-CORPORA-01 sequence.
