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Abstract

Where the Algorithmic Kernel (#1414) demonstrates the midrashim transform M unfolding Revelation forward into the later New Testament, this page demonstrates the other direction: the executable Sapphic apparatus T, frozen as twelve clauses before its most radical candidate was scored (#1494), running through the tradition that feeds the Apocalypse. Six plates in the Kernel's own idiom: Longinus, the quotation-joint performed, the one ancient carrier holding both the name and the theory; Philo, the machine legislated as doctrine with the name absent — the suppression signature in its purest ancient form; Addition D into Antiquities 11, the forward realization with the sequence table and Josephus's two restorations toward the poem; Bellum 1, the inverted realization stitched by the six-occurrence ἀναζωπυρέω; the Slavonic carrier, status CONTESTED carried openly on the plate itself, with the negative search and pericope provenance chipped to seat 12; and Revelation 12 as the counter-stack's first transform-view edition — the seated Nestle text rendered verse by verse with station chips, a TEXT/TRANSFORM toggle, the sealed test's 8-of-9 scorecard with C6's double weight displayed, and the C1 failure and both negative sub-findings reported on the page in red. Every Greek and Hebrew quotation is drawn from EA-CORPORA-01 seats — commit-pinned, SHA-256 manifested — so the page's provenance is itself inspectable; every plate is chipped to its founding deposit; and the closing section states plainly what the demonstration does not assert.
